

## **BOWLS LEICESTERSHIRE BENEVOLENT FUND**

*Comprising of the Benevolent Fund (Founded 1948) Reg Charity No 215632  
and Flower Fund Revised Charities Act 1993*

1. The Fund shall be known as the Bowls Leicestershire Benevolent Fund and shall be maintained by voluntary donations from clubs and individuals and from other sources that the Executive Committee may adopt.
2. The Benevolent Fund was awarded Charitable Status in 1948 and it shall be managed by an Executive Committee consisting of a minimum of two and maximum of four Trustees.
3. The Executive Committee shall appoint replacement Trustees in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Charity Commission.
4. The Executive shall appoint one of the Trustees to act as Treasurer and shall be administered by a Secretary appointed by the Executive Committee.
5. The Fund shall be lodged in a Bank Account in the name of the Trustees and shall be operated by the Signatures of the Treasurer jointly with either the Secretary or one nominated Trustee.
6. The Fund shall be used to grant money to assist those necessitous bowlers who are or who have recently been a member of a club affiliated to Bowls Leicestershire. The Trustees may, at their discretion make grants to necessitous dependants of deceased members in exceptional circumstances. Donations may, from time to time, also be made to Charities at the discretion of the Trustees.
7. Applications for any grant for assistance for members shall be made in writing to the Secretary of the Fund by the Committee of the members Club, however, the Trustees, can be approached by any club member directly in order to maintain personal confidentiality.
8. The financial year shall be 1 January - 31st December.

The object of the Fund is to help all members of the Men's Section who are in need of assistance and this can only be made possible if each and every Club contributes annually to the Fund. Grants are also made to widows of recently deceased members.

Recommendations for assistance often are made through the Committees of Clubs to the Secretary of the Fund. The Trustees are aware that members in the interest of personal confidentiality may prefer to contact the Trustees directly. Every personal approach will be dealt with as quickly as possible
